Read Romans 1:18-32

In what ways do group members see or know of the wrath of God being revealed against godliness and wickedness?

Three times it is said '*God gave them over...*'

What do group members think this means and how do they feel about it?

What things do group members think we see people 'given over to' in our society today?

Do group members have friends/family/work colleagues/neighbours that they sense are 'given over'?

Share about situations and then pray for their deliverance and fresh revelation of God and his grace.
