Acts 4:32-5:42

These questions are given as a guide. Please do not feel you have to read them out as written – make them your own in leading us through together. The important thing about our Word time is that we get to applying the Word to our lives and not just do a Bible study, so make sure that questions and prayer and ministry in response helps in this.

Word

Read Acts 4: 32-5:42

(To read it may seem a long task, but someone in your group may not have heard it read on Sunday, or may be unfamiliar with it).

1. Why do members think the believers shared so extravagantly?
If the Bible is our pattern how should believers live today?
Is there anything members are thinking about specifically doing differently in the near future?
Perhaps one or two might be willing to share their intentions.
2. If Christianity were illegal in the UK, would there be enough evidence to convict you?
Invite members to write down sufficient 'damning' facts about themselves to prove 'beyond reasonable doubt', that they would be found guilty. (You will probably need to provide papers and pens).
