

## **Cell notes for week beginning 24/04/11**

***Jesus rises from the dead***

Luke 24:1-49

*These questions are given as a guide. Please do not feel you have to read them out as written – make them your own in leading us through together. The important thing about our Word time is that we get to applying the Word to our lives and not just do a Bible study, so make sure that questions and prayer and ministry in response helps in this.*

### **Word**

READ Luke 24:1-49

What areas of disbelief do we struggle with in sharing our faith?

How can the changes we read of, and have experienced ourselves help us in sharing the gospel with others?

Take time to pray into any areas of struggle in belief in group members and pray for the joy of the Lord to come and invade spirits.
