

## **Cell notes for week beginning 06/03/11**

### ***God knows the future***

Daniel 2:1-23

*These questions are given as a guide. Please do not feel you have to read them out as written – make them your own in leading us through together. The important thing about our Word time is that we get to applying the Word to our lives and not just do a Bible study, so make sure that questions and prayer and ministry in response helps in this.*

### **Word**

The thrust of my message is that in the times when there is so much advancements made in science, technology and knowledge in general even Christians need to be reminded that we still need God now as they did then - may be more. Only believers are in touch with God and this needs to be evidenced by impact and influence they will have in their generation. Only God is all knowing, all present and all powerful. He knows the future and the end from the beginning.

READ Daniel 2:1-23

Based on the passage may be the cell groups can discuss:

1. Human knowledge contrasted with God's knowledge  
Do our lives depend more on God than on our own abilities and thereby be witnesses for Jesus?
2. When the world (human effort) has failed how can believers take advantage and introduce the Lord into the picture?
3. Discuss the importance of corporate prayer (praying with others as a family, cell or church).
4. How can we help people who are religious (those who believe in a god or supernatural power) but don't know Jesus?

There may be no right or wrong answers to the above questions and cells need not limit themselves to this - the questions are only meant to help cell groups apply the message to their situations and people are free to do it their own usual way!
